Please note that, although the London TravelCard *does* pay for **London Underground** transportation from Heathrow or London City Airports to London, it does *not* cover fares for the more convenient **Express Trains** that operate from Heathrow, Gatwick, and Stansted Airports to London.

The TFL website includes an extremely handy **Journey Planner**. Enter a Station or Stop, Post code, Address, or Place of Interest in the FROM column ... Enter a Station or Stop, Post code, Address, or Place of Interest in the TO column ... Click on LEAVE NOW.

**Advanced Options** include being able to specify the date and time of travel; requesting the fastest routes, the routes with fewest changes, or the routes with the least walking between them; and the ability to “Deselect” modes of transportation you don't want to use.
